- □ Meet your <u>Placement Specialist</u> and setup your troop meeting details
- Join the New Leader Academy Facebook Group & the New Leader Rallyhood
- □ Find a co-leader and invite girls to join your troop – printable invite
- □ Complete required training: TR100: New leader Training; TR402: Protecting Our Girls; & GSUSA Grade Level Essentials in <u>gsLearn</u>
- Meet your <u>Troop Support Coordinator</u> your main point of contact for support

Week 3

- □ Complete your bank account set-up and make your first deposit
- □ Request a free Rallyhood rally site for your troop. The Rallyhood platfrom combines the functionality of tools like Evenbrite, SignUp Genius, Facebook, and Google Calendar/Forms in one place. Troops can customize their sites with photos and information, creating a space for volunteers and parents to communicate
- Plan and hold your first troop meeting Use vour New Leader Handbook & the Volunteer Toolkit

Week 2

- □ Complete new leader training (complete within the first 60 days)
- □ Discover the ins and outs of the Volunteer Toolkit
- □ Find a bank for your troop bank account and submit the opening a bank account form – GSNETX Bank Account Process Request to Open a Bank Account
- Meet with your co-leader and plan a parent meeting using the **Sample** Family Meeting Agenda from your New Leader Kit.
- □ Find your troop roster in the <u>Volunteer</u> Toolkit. Email, text, or call troop parents to introduce yourself
- □ Hold the parent meeting (remember to use your meeting agenda)
