

Internet Safety Pledge

Girl Scout Internet Safety Pledge* for all girls

On my honor, I pledge that:

- I will not give out personal information such as my full name (only my first name and last name initial will be used), address, telephone number(s), parent's or guardians' work address/telephone number(s), and the name and location of my school without the permission of my parent or guardian.
- I will tell an adult right away if I come across or receive any information that makes me feel uncomfortable.
 - I understand that chat logs will be to the presenter (GSNETX) or the group only.
- I will always follow the rules of Internet sites and program platforms, including those rules that are based on age of use, parental approval and knowledge, and public laws.
- I will never agree to get together with someone I "meet" online without first checking with my parents or guardians. If my parents or guardian agree to a meeting, I will arrange it in a public place and bring a parent or guardian along.
- I will never send a person my picture or anything else without first checking with my parent or guardian.
 - I will not take screen shots of presentations, chat rooms, or profile pictures of the participants while online and/or in virtual sessions.
 - If I do share on social media about my online experience, I will have all social media settings to private, my contacts only, no public viewing.
- I will talk with my parent or guardian so that we can set up rules for going online. We will decide on the time of day that I can be online, the length of time that I can be online, and appropriate areas for me to visit. I will not access other areas or break these rules without their permission.
- I will not use the internet to collect money for Girl Scout products other than what is specifically permitted and outlined in the safety guidelines related to Girl Scout product sales.
- I will practice online "netiquette" (good manners) at all times when online by:
 - Not spamming others.
 - Not bullying or tolerating bullying (and will always tell a trusted adult if this is a problem).
 - Not using bad language.
- I will be guided by the Girl Scout Promise and Law in all that I do online.
